Tony and his twin brother were inseparable, connected by that extraordinary bond that only twins can know. But when they were nine years old, the boys were torn apart. "My mother gave my brother up to foster care without ever telling me why," Tony says.

Though he and his brother stayed in touch from time to time, Tony always felt like a part of him was missing. But when he started a family of his own, his love for his children helped fill the emptiness. And when his wife abandoned the family, leaving Tony to raise the children alone, he poured all his energy into loving them. "I was inspired to work hard, happy that I could take care of them," he says.

But when they grew up and

left home, that old feeling of emptiness returned and Tony fell into depression. Eventually, he stopped working and began numbing his pain with

drugs. "I realized I needed to refocus my life," he says.

It was then he came to the Mission as a Resident Volunteer, helping to maintain our facility. "I wanted to give back

because they were giving me shelter and food," he says. "I immersed myself in the work as therapy."

But he knew it wasn't enough. He needed to address the root causes of his depression, so he entered our LifeChange Recovery Program. Through chapel services, Bible studies and oneon-one counseling, his faith has grown strong and he's healed from his childhood wounds. "I discovered I'd been harboring

resentment towards my mother for giving up my brother," he says. "After 44 years, those emotions all came pouring out."

Tony plans to graduate from the program, find work and his own place, and live each day with joy, free of the pain that hindered him for so long.

Thanks to the blessing of your support, Tony is celebrating Easter with a new lease on life. "Coming to the Mission has refocused me. It's changed my life."
