But as a young man, he fell prey to the sickness of addiction. "I don't even remember how it started, but drug and alcohol use took over my attitude, my mind and even my body."

One by one, he lost the trust of the ones he loved the most: his parents, siblings, friends, and his girlfriend, who cared deeply for him but couldn't stand by and watch him destroy his life.

After losing his job, he found himself homeless – oftentimes in a tent that had to be constantly moved. "I felt like I was just... nothing."

Finally, after 13 unmanageable years, he was ready for change.

The day Randolf learned about our LifeChange Program, he knew that there was hope for recovery.

"At first, I couldn't move past my embarrassment and guilt, but I learned to live without shame by focusing on gratitude."

With nourishing food and a safe place to sleep, Randolf is amazed and grateful. He participates in the Mission's life-changing classes, work therapy and – through lots of prayer – he's on track to become whole again.

"I'm working toward getting my mind right as I learn more about the Lord."

He lost his mother before she was able to see how far he'd come, but day by day, he's regaining the trust of his brothers and sister through phone calls, visits and meals together.

At the Mission, he gives back by working in the kitchen and helping to keep the common areas neat and clean. "Things are so much better. With God's help, I'll never go back to that old life again."

Randolf's heart is overflowing with gratitude this Thanksgiving because YOUR loving support gave him the confidence to rebuild. "Here at the Mission, I'm never lonely. And I know that with Jesus in my heart, I can stay healthy and happy."
