


Thank you for giving me – and countless guests at Bread of Life Mission – a reason to give thanks this fall!

"The **Lord**is present here."

Robert's childhood was marked by neglect and abuse. His father traveled the majority of the year for work, and during those long stretches of him being away, Robert and his sister experienced abuse from a family member. But his father was indifferent: "My dad didn't care to talk about any of that."

After his parents divorced, Robert felt he had to step up and be the man of the house at just age 10. The pressure of having to grow up so early without family stability ended up being too much. After high school, Robert started experimenting with drugs and alcohol. Sadly, substance use led him down a dark path and eventually contributed to going in and out of homelessness for decades. "It was just a revolving, vicious cycle of insanity."

Having grown up in Washington, Robert knew about the various recovery programs in the area, and went through many different treatment programs.

But when he came to Bread of Life Mission, he knew something was different. "This program is more spiritual... it's more Christian-based," he said. "I could see it in the people here."

Robert says the Mission has renewed his spiritual life and desire to grow in his personal life, values and morals. The classes and the people he's met through them have especially been an encouragement: "The other guests here have been through the same issues I have."

"Coming to the Mission, I have hope. I really have a strong belief that it's going to be OK this time, and I will build that relationship with Christ."


Once he graduates from the program, Robert hopes to maintain sobriety, find a job and have a strong relationship with the Lord.
